• The Raven

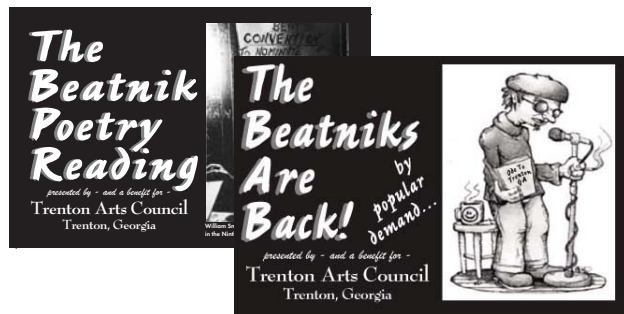
